Preschool


Preschool is headed by Mrs. Lubna Imran (M.Ed. & Post Graduate Montessori Diploma)

Junior Section


Mrs. Qamar-Un-Nisa Shahid (MA Political Science)

Middle Section


Mrs. Mussarat Hayat (MA English & Diploma TEFL)


Senior Section

Know the Rules

- The institution demands a high order of punctuality regularity from its students.
- Students must reach school / college at least 5 minutes before the morning assembly. Late comers will not be entertained.
- Leave application must be submitted in writing before morning assembly, if the student has to be absent due to any reason.
- The name of the student will be struck off from school / college strength if:
 - He/she is absent for consecutive 10 days without intimation.
 - Fee is not paid for consecutive 2 months.
 - He/She receive three warning letters for misbehavior.
- Failure to submit application for leave will render a student to fine of Rs. 50/per day.
- Students suffering from contagious diseases should not attend the class.
- The institution is no way responsible/accountable for loss of books, equipments, money or any other valuables lost by the students.
- Students are not allowed to see visitors in the institution.
- No students can invite any outsider in the institution without prior permission of the Principal.
- Usage of Mobile phones is strictly prohibited in school college premises.
- Consent of the parents for excursion or educational trips arranged by the school/college is asked in writing. The institution takes no responsibility for any damage/mishap during such trips.
- No sectarian or political functions are permitted to be held by the students in the school / college premises.
- Institution reserves the right to transfer the child to any other campus of DHAI-R at any time.
- APA&C/DHAI-R authorities have the right to take action against Students/ Parents / Guardians for their misconduct.
- As per APSACS policy students failing twice will not be allowed to continue in the institution.
- Short leave during school / college time is discouraged. In case of emergency only, student will be sent with parents/guardian.
- Due to security reasons, no visitor is allowed to enter school / college without showing his/her identity card at school entrance gate.
- No belonging of visitors is allowed in school / college premises.

Discipline & Conduct

The following offences will render a student liable to warning, depending on the gravity of the offence:

- Indiscipline, cheating, stealing or immoral conduct.
- ➤ Rudeness to staff/ancillary staff either by student/parents.
- Keeping firearms and other lethal weapons.
- Willfully damaging Institution's property.
- Being habitually untidy, unpunctual and neglecting Institution's order.
- Leaving Institution's premises without prior permission.
- Smoking and using narcotics.
- Any other offence deemed to be serious enough by the Institution's Discipline Committee appointed by the Principal.

Security



Light refreshments along with snacks and other eatables are available in the tuck shop.


















